In 2011, a year that Casse described as "crazy good," he smashed the record for wins by a trainer in a season when he visited the Woodbine winner's circle 119

times. The previous record had been 89 set by Frank Passero Jr. in 1995. Casse's stable amassed more purse earnings on the season, \$6.6 million, than any other trainer in Woodbine history, bettering its

own record from four years ago.

Casse has been nominated for a Sovereign Award as Canada's outstanding trainer for the eighth straight time, and he is favored to win his fourth such trophy

"I feel like, through all these years, we have been climbing up Mt. Everest," said Casse about his pursuit of winning the big ones. "I can see the top of it, but the last part is the toughest."

#### A Natural

A life in Thoroughbred racing came naturally for Casse, whose father, Norman Casse, operated a successful breeding business in Indiana before moving to one of the major horse centers of the continent—Ocala. Fla.

Born in Indianapolis on Valentine's Day 1961, Casse was barely a teenager by the time he was running his father's Cardinal Hill Farm outside Ocala and learning the tricks of training, pedigrees, and buying his own broodmares.

One of the most vivid memories that Casse has with his father is a trip in a horse van they took to see the legendary Secretariat win the Kentucky Derby in 1973.

But a life in the horse racing industry for Casse was almost short-circuited when his parents divorced when he was just 13.

"I asked my Mom if I could stay with Dad and stay with the horses," said an emotional Casse. "It was probably one of the hardest things she had to do, but that's how much she loved me."

From there Casse set sail on his way to becoming not only a top racehorse trainer but an ace bloodstock and farm manager.

At 18, he obtained his trainer's license and won his first race at Keeneland race-course in Lexington.

Casse led all trainers at the 1988 Churchill Downs spring meeting, setting a record for number of winners, 29, for the stand. He later went on to win the trainer's title at Turfway Park in Florence, Ky., four times.

It was not just training that piqued Casse's interest, however, and in the 1990s he took over as manager and trainer of operations for Harry Mangurian's massive Mockingbird Farm in Ocala.

It was during his years with Mangurian that Casse began to race horses regularly at Woodbine, including the 1999 champion 2-year-old male Exciting Story, who went on to win the 2001 Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I).

While at Mockingbird, Casse excelled at preparing young horses for sales and the races and selling them for a profit. It was a vastly successful venture until Mangurian dispersed much of his bloodstock in 1999 and 2000.

After three years as manager of Sez Who Racing, Casse opened up his own training complex, Moonshadow Farm near Ocala, with his wife, Tina.

Enter Melnyk, who purchased the Mangurian property and renamed it Winding Oaks, and Woodford Racing, a syndicate run by Bill Farish. With those entities behind him, Casse and his training business

surged back up the charts.

He won his first Sovereign Award as champion trainer in 2006.

In 2007 he guided Melnyk's Sealy Hill to win the Labatt Woodbine Oaks and ultimately a Horse of the Year title, earning Casse another Sovereign Award in the process.

"Eugene can breed any kind of top horse at any time," said Casse. "I was proud of Sealy Hill; she was a quirky kind of filly who presented some challenges along the way." Farish has also played an important role in Casse's rise to a higher level in recent years. Woodford Racing's colt Turf War gave Casse his first victory in a \$1 million race, when the Dixie Union colt dead-heated with Z Humor in the 2007 Boyd Gaming's Delta Jackpot Stakes (gr. III) at Delta Downs.

Now Oxley, who gave the reins to Casse to make some big-money purchases at auctions in the last two years, has joined the Casse team.

"He's (Oxley) been in the game for 30

years; he's already won a Derby, but you never lose the desire to win the Derby," said Casse. "And he really wants to win a Queen's Plate, too. He realizes what a wonderful place Woodbine is to race horses."

As the big races for 2012 loom on the horizon, Oxley's colts Prospective, who won the Grey Stakes (Can-III) last fall, maiden winner Stealcase, and the promising Dynamical are all on a Derby quest.

Oxley's Canadian-bred filly Dixie Strike, a half sister to 2011 Plate winner Inglorious, won the \$150,000 Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs Feb. 4 and could be headed to the Kentucky Oaks before heading back to Canada.

#### **Tools of the Trade**

Casse's morning ritual is unlike that of most trainers at Woodbine. It begins at 5 a.m. when he heads into the track from his home in nearby Kleinburg, Ontario, and inspects each one of his 40 horses that are working or racing that day or did so on the previous day. That can be almost half the barn sometimes.

"We will jog them around the shed or outside of the barn to see how they are doing," said Casse. "That takes some time."

With the rest of the daily work schedule in everyone's hands, Casse heads over to

"I prefer to see how my horses finish in their exercise," said Casse. "If I see something I don't like, I can stop it right away by radioing the riders."

On his laptop Casse has a spreadsheet

he began compiling 10 years ago that details each horse's training schedule and progress. Including another 40-50 horses at nearby T & T Training center, that can make more than 90 horses that he updates each evening.

"I don't really have a true day off, but I

training careers, from Tom Albertrani and Kiaran McLaughlin from the Kentucky days to Woodbine trainers Greg de Gannes and Ricky Griffith. "I am proud of my Woodbine team," said Casse. "I never have any worries. Everyone who works for me knows their duties and what is expected."

And, expensive purchases aside, Casse also prides himself on those horses he has picked up for minimal sums such as millionaires Financingavailable (\$3,205) and Jambalaya (\$2,500), whom he picked out for other owners.

Casse also tries to ensure all of his owners, which include longtime clients Richard Lederman and Harvey Schwartz, have an enjoyable time with their horses from the day the training begins to race day.

"I try to tell it the way it is," said Casse. "Mr. Farish once said to me, 'promise less; deliver more.' I try to be realistic with my owners. It's their money and their horses and they need to be happy, so I try to make sure they are involved."

Casse approaches his profession tirelessly, juggling his horses and family life while taking time out for his clients and the constant ringing of the phone, often a member of the media asking about a runner.

"Sometimes Tina will ask me, 'are we always going to be this crazy busy?' And I tell her we are flying a big plane and she's the co-pilot. I'm living a dream, I just love it, and we are going to keep flying it while we can and keep striving for the top."


