Red River Keeps Swinging

Adcock family continues a winning tradition

JOE ADCOCK LEFT BEHIND his home in Coushatta, La., to travel the country for 16 years as a Major League Baseball player, but the roots he re-established in the small northwest Louisiana town after his retirement from the diamond have grown into one of the state's few remaining farms dedicated to Thoroughbreds.

sees Red River Farms near Coushatta with his wife, Terry. The elder Adcock grew up with working and riding horses, and when he arrived in visiting cities as a ballplayer, mainly as a first baseman for the Milwaukee Braves, he gravitated to area racetracks and the people who were in the horse business. After a career in which the strapping power hitter socked 336 home runs, including four in one game in 1954, he concentrated his efforts on equines.

"He had Appaloosas for a long while to ride and go quail hunting," said Jay. "Late in his career with the Los Angeles Angels, he was on a talk show in California and mentioned he had a farm with Appaloosa mares and yearlings, and the following autumn somebody who had heard him on the show came out here from California and bought nearly all his Appaloosas and

ribbons and belt buckles he was winning for the Appaloosas might look really good, but they weren't gonna pay real good. The only horses you could make money with were ones that ran at the racetrack."

Jay Adcock, 59, grew up on Red River the oldest of Joe Adcock's four children, and during summers the family would follow Adcock around to wherever he was playing. When the elder Adcock began his Thoroughbred operation, it was with one or two stallions and a dozen mares. Jay, after going through pre-vet programs at Louisiana Tech where he also played first base on the baseball team, returned to the 225-acre farm in 1981 and helped grow Red River. His dad died in 1999. Today, the farm stands 10 stallions that serve breeders who are mostly from Louisiana and Texas.

"We've got 150 stalls, paddocks, and four or five bigger pastures," said Jay Adcock. "One thing we make sure to do is each horse goes into a stall and gets individually fed twice a day. If one needs more feed, one needs less, others need this or that, we can take care of their individual needs. Somebody on this farm has to look at each horse twice a day-morning and afternoon—so that we identify as soon as possible anything that might be going wrong."

The farm, which is about 45 miles from Louisiana Downs (in Bossier City), is where Jay's grandfather grew up before

moving into Coushatta proper, which is home to 1,200 residents. The farm was sold and then bought back by the family. Evangeline Downs is a two-hour car ride away; Delta Downs is three hours; and Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots in New Orleans about five hours. Although the Coushatta area doesn't have as rich

a Thoroughbred history as Lafayette, which is near Evangeline and is the cradle of civilization as far as jockeys go, Adcock said he remembers bush track races much like the ones that Hall of Fame riders Eddie Delahoussaye and Randy Romero cut their teeth on farther south.

"I guess we eat a little more up here and

grew bigger than the jockeys that come from Lafayette," Adcock joked. "Those guys down there began riding when they were 8 years old, but we had straightaway races up here as well. They'd run 'catch weight.' They'd put chickens, or whatever they could catch, on the horse for weight. I've seen chickens on the back of a horse

running down a straightaway. Absolutely. At the end of the race, you'd have to go catch the damn things."

Adcock and a staff of about a dozen foal between 80 and 100 mares per year. He makes the pilgrimage to Kentucky in November to attend the breeding stock sales, replenishing his band with a handful of purchases of prospective broodmares.

"I buy wherever I can and whatever I can afford," Adcock noted. "Keeneland is like the Super Bowl of horse sales. You've got a variety, and you can find one for a couple of dollars or one for the most money you want to spend. It's not that you can't find good horses elsewhere, but for someone like myself, if I'm going to shop in one place, that's the place to be."

The market is competitive, however, and it's tough for regional operations to invest a lot of money into bloodlines more suited to Kentucky. But because of expanded gaming in Louisiana and a come-

back for the oil industry after some tough years, business is on the upswing, particularly with horsemen in Texas looking at greener grass across state lines.

"The regional markets that have slot machines have picked up; like it or not, we can't survive without them," Adcock said. "Look at our neighbors in Texas. They have 27 million people there, and they can't keep three racetracks running for a decent meet. We have 4.5 million people in Louisiana, and we've got four racetracks that run at least 80 days a year, and it's because of the slot machines. You go to the racetracks or the boats that have casinos, and I guarantee you 75% of the people in there are from Texas.

"Our farm is only about an hour from the border with Texas, and once the industry there took a downward turn, we got quite a bit of business from east Texas and the Dallas/Ft. Worth area. A lot of our breedings come from those areas."

Red River Farms has a history of stand-

ing solid stud horses. Adcock cites past stallions such as Sir Richard Lewis, Bag, Plain Dealing, and especially Leestown, whom he calls the best stallion he's stood to date.

"He started his stud career in Louisiana and had 11 crops before he broke his shoulder in a paddock accident," said Adcock. "Fortune wasn't smiling on me that day, but his 11 crops ran out \$23 million. For a horse to stand in a regional program and average more than \$2 million a year in progeny earnings, I've never had my hands on anything else like that.

"But once you've had a good one, if you've got any competitiveness in you, you want another good one. You can't hit if you don't swing, so I'm still in there swinging."

Adcock is bringing in Takeover Target to stand at Red River in 2018. The Harlan's Holiday son earned better than \$825,000 and won grade 2 events on turf.

He will join veteran Gold Tribute, a son of Mr. Prospector, at the farm. Gold Tribute, who will be 24 in 2018, will breed a smaller book of mares than when he was younger, but Adcock noted he's been "solid as a rock and very good to the farm."

A Claiborne Farm homebred son of Pulpit named Bind stands at Red River. His promising career, which included a fast maiden win first time out, was ended by injury, but Bind is well bred and off to a fast start at stud. His first crop of 2-yearolds in 2017 featured six winners from 12 starters and four first-out winners,

and Adcock is high on him.

Guilt Trip, another Pulpit son, is a winner of the grade 2 Strub Stakes at Santa Anita Park who earned just more than \$300,000. His first crop will be 2-yearolds of 2018. Calibrachoa, a five-time graded stakes winner in New York, also stands at Red River. The Southern Image horse made more than \$660,000.

Adcock stands Redding Collier, by Mineshaft, who won more than \$775,000 and is a multiple graded stakes winner. Interactif, a son of Broken Vow who was a multiple graded stakes winner on turf, earned more than \$560,0000. Sum of the Parts, a multiple graded stakes winner at Keeneland and a son of Speightstown, has

his first crop are also 2-year-olds. Adcock is putting together a deal to stand Jay Gatsby in 2018. The son of Giant's Causeway is a half brother to top stallion War Front.

Adcock noted that three-quarters of

the races run in Louisiana are six furlongs or shorter, so the emphasis in the state is on speed as well as on precocious 2-vear-olds.

"First impressions are always a good thing, in both horses and people," he said.

"I want a stallion that, when he walks out in front of people, you're not going to have to start making excuses; a horse that catches your eye and has some appeal to him.

"'Bull' Hancock had the criteria of wanting a horse that broke his maiden in his first couple of starts and ran well at 2, and I want a horse that follows that as well. And has some speed and a good female family. But I can't fight Kentucky or the top couple of regional programs because we don't have that kind of money to compete with them. You can't buy a stud for a lot of money because you can't make it back on stud fees here. The highest stud fee on the farm is \$2,500, so that limits what you can afford to spend. It's a chess game-what can I get for the amount of money I have to spend?"

While Leestown in his prime bred 100 mares, a solid book in Louisiana these days is 50-60. Only some 1,250 babies are born in the state now, down from a high of about 3,000, and that includes mares that were bred to out-of-state stallions

but foal in Louisiana. If the mare is bred to a stallion in Louisiana following the out-of-state-sired baby being born, both foals are considered Louisiana-breds.

That designation is key for breeders looking to reap benefits from the state-bred breeders' program, which returns 18% to them when a horse they bred runs 1-2-3 in any race in the state and in any stakes race out of state. In addition, a minimum of three Louisiana-bred races are carded daily at each racetrack, and a Champions Day is also held by each track every year. The Dec. 9, 2017, Champions Day at Fair Grounds featured eight Thoroughbred races that together were worth more than \$1 million.

"We've got a good, solid little program down here," said Adcock. "Our breeders' program has been as high as 22%, and it's still good at 18%. I keep a lot of horses for outside people who are here because of the breeders' award program. They get 18% after selling the horse to someone who's paying all the bills. Sure, the winning owner gets 60% of the purse, but by the time he pays the trainer and jockey, you're down to 40% with all the bills and risk."

Louisiana horsemen have other advantages. Those located in the central part of the state can van their horses to each of the four racetracks without having to pack up tack and move from location to location. Three of the four facilities offer turf racing as well, and the circuit runs year 'round.

Also, for the past six years, the Equine Sales Company has taken charge of the auction market in the state. Located near Evangeline Downs in Opelousas, Equine Sales has a modern facility with 228 stalls and backing from the Louisiana Thoroughbred Breeders Association. It runs a mixed sale in October, a yearling sale at the end of August, and a 2-year-old sale in May. Numbers have trended up the past couple of years.

"If you get a good enough horse to take to a bigger market, great," said Adcock, "but probably 80% of my horses sell in Louisiana, most as yearlings. Some Florida pinhookers have had some good luck coming in and taking horses to Florida and reselling them, but the majority of them stay and race around here."

Adcock doesn't regret leaving vet school behind for his life on the farm.

"I wouldn't change a thing," he said. "This business has been good to me. The goal is to raise a good horse, and we've done that (among Jay, his father, his wife, and his sons, the Adcock family has bred 60 stakes winners). Terry handles all the sales prep and paperwork, and everyone in the family has raised a Louisiana champion."

Older son Joseph co-bred seven-time stakes winner Tortuga Straits (by Gold Tribute, \$831,573) and six-time stakes winner Tortuga Flats (\$594,064); Terry bred I Dazzle, a three-time stakes win-

ner of nearly \$400,000; and younger son Brandon bred Pacific Pink, a six-time stakes-winning daughter of Private Vow.

Said Adcock, "For everybody in my family to have raised a horse that's the best somewhere, and to have each feel that joy, that's as good as it gets to me."
