MIDWEST/CANADA Standing Tall Ivan Dalos improves the

breed at Tall Oaks Farm

IVAN DALOS HAS A KNACK for nicks.

The Toronto, Ontario, businessman will tell you his foray into Thoroughbred racing and breeding began purely by chance. He will tell you one of the first horses he bred, Victory Gallop-who stunned the racing world when he won the 1998 Belmont Stakes (G1)-was a "fluke."

But there has been nothing accidental about the rise of Dalos' self-made bloodlines, which have made his Tall Oaks Farm one of the most successful breeding and racing operations in Canadian history.

For four months each year, May to August, Dalos is immersed in pedigrees and stallion books, planning matings for his broodmare band come the following spring. He doesn't own a farm, but his mares reside at Rene and Darlene Hunderup's Norse Ridge Farms near King City, Ontario, and Nick Lotz' Briarbrooke Farm near Paris, Ky.

The work has paid off. Dalos' Tall Oaks homebreds have given him a dramatic rise to the top of the breeder and owner charts in the last five years. He has bred international stakes winners and several champions-including Victory Gallopand at the 2016 Sovereign Awards, Tall Oaks was beaten a nose in the voting by the mighty Adena Springs.

All of this has taken place with an annual foal crop of less than two dozen.

Dalos is coming off his biggest year yet, highlighted by the exploits of his mare Ami's Mesa, who looked a winner deep in the stretch run of the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (G1) last Nov. 4 at Del Mar, only to be pipped at the wire by Chester and Mary Broman's Bar of Gold.

Dalos watched that race from the Woodbine Club lounge with Michelle, one of his three daughters (Colleen, the middle

daughter, attended the Breeders' Cup on behalf of the family) as his wife, Irene, was at home due to illness.

"There was a lot of screaming in the lounge from everyone who was there. I thought for a second, 'Look at this; this is the real thing.' But, hey, there's no shame in finishing second in a Breeders' Cup race with a homebred," said Dalos,

Dalos did not even know horse racing existed when he came to Canada from Hungary at about the same time E.P. Taylor opened the new Woodbine racetrack in 1956.

Dalos was busy putting together a flooring and construction business in Toronto and raising a family when, in the 1970s, an excited sub-contractor awaiting a check caught the attention of Dalos.



"The guy was really fidgety, so I asked him if he was in a hurry," said Dalos. "He said he had to get to the racetrack. I thought he meant dog racing, I had no idea they raced horses. The only time I ever saw a horse (as a child) was pulling the milk or ice wagons at home in Hungary."

Dalos tagged along with the man, Les Meszaros, and within a month he had put up about \$10,000 to claim a horse with his new friend.

"In the first race I was looking all around for this horse and couldn't find her; she was so far back in last place," remembered Dalos.

That first experience did not deter him, however, as he was enamored by the beauty of the Thoroughbred.

"I started reading everything left, right, and center," said Dalos. "Every breeding book, system, and pedigree. I wanted to learn everything I could about it."

While he continued to dabble in the claiming game in the early 1980s with Meszaros; his brother-in-law; and trainer George Bankuti, Dalos was determined to buy a mare to begin breeding his own horses.

Silly Billie (Buckaroo—Catch Sunny, by Sunny Clime), who showed some ability on the track for owner George Ledson in 1988-89, was the first of two life-changing purchases by Dalos.

"She was a granddaughter of Buckpasser and I had read he was a top broodmare sire. Since I didn't have much money to spend and could not afford a Buckpasser mare, this seemed close enough," Dalos said.

From his hours of reading racing texts and periodicals, Dalos knew Buckpasser blood crossed well with the Northern Dancer line, so he chose the affordable Ontario sire Alwasmi, a son of Northern Dancer, for Silly Billie's first mating.

The resultant filly Dalos named Sybelle Ami, made up from the letters in the sire and dam's names.

A fast filly, Sybelle Ami was too quick for her legs; she fractured one knee and was operated on, then fractured the other one.

"I kept her and looked around for a Mr. Prospector-line stallion because he goes well with Northern Dancer. I found Secret Claim (at Windfields Farm) and the result was Secret Ami, the best horse I bred up to that point."

Secret Ami was stakes-placed at Woodbine in 1998-99 and earned more than \$120,000 before she entered Dalos' broodmare band.

At around the time that Silly Billie settled in as the first official Tall Oaks mare, Dalos went to the Woodbine yearling sale to shop for more broodmare prospects.

While watching the sale and chatting with other onlookers, Dalos noticed a daughter of premier Canadian sire Vice Regent in the ring. The stallion commanded a \$50,000 stud fee but the filly was not getting a lot of interest.

"She was going up in increments of \$1,000; up to \$22,000, 23, 24...I asked a guy beside me what was wrong with her," said Dalos. "He didn't know. So I put up my hand at \$25,000 and it stuck. A bit later someone walked up to me and told me the filly would never race because she was quite offset in her knees."

But Victorious Lil didn't know about her knees and went on to become a stakes winner of more than \$170,000. Upon her retire-

ment, she was bred to blue-collar stud Cryptoclearance, a longwinded racehorse who had finished second behind Bet Twice in the 1987 Belmont.

As Dalos' herd continued to grow, he began selling any colts his mares produced. When Victorious Lil produced a plain-looking bay colt, Dalos sent him to the 1996 Keeneland September yearling sale where he brought a modest \$25,000.

Purchased by Prestonwood Farm after the colt's first five starts, Victory Gallop went on to finish second in both the 1998 Kentucky Derby (G1) and Preakness Stakes (G1) behind Real Quiet before squashing that colt's Triple Crown bid by a nose in the Belmont.

"That horse, he was a fluke," said Dalos. "I thought he could be OK, but I never expected he would be that good."

Victory Gallop, who went on to win an Eclipse Award as the champion older male of 1999, is a member of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame and the sire of three of Dalos' best broodmares.

In 2001, Secret Ami was, naturally enough, bred to Victory Gallop, producing Victorious Ami. Dalos sent Secret Ami to the

stallion again in 2005 and got Galloping Ami.

Victorious Ami won the 2004 Princess Elizabeth Stakes, the biggest race for 2-year-old Canadian-bred fillies, and went on to produce the 2011 Breeders' Stakes winner Ami's Holiday (by Harlan's Holiday), the first classic winner kept and raced by Dalos.

Ami's Mesa, a 2013 foal by Sky Mesa–Victorious Ami, was a Woodbine stakes winner at 2 and then had her breakout year in 2017, winning the Presque Isle Downs Masters Stakes (G2) before her brilliant Breeders' Cup run.

Galloping Ami, who never raced, is the dam of stakes winner Aragorn Ami (by Aragorn), graded stakes winner Ami's Flatter (by Flatter), and 2016 graded stakes winner Amis Gizmo to the cover of Ontario sire Giant Gizmo. Amis Gizmo and Galloping Ami earned Dalos' first ever Sovereign Awards for champion

3-year-old male and outstanding broodmare, respectively.

Dalos has started working on other lines of breeding as well. Keen Victory, another unraced daughter of Victory Gallop, is off to a profitable start as a broodmare. Her first foal Keen Gizmo (by Giant Gizmo) has won more than \$340,000 while her 2013 colt, Conquest Enforcer (by Into Mischief), sold by Dalos for \$210,000 at auction, was named Canada's 2016 champion grass horse.

Even Dalos' daughter Colleen got in on the fun when she purchased Gambling Girl, a daughter of Secret Claim, as a yearling in 1994. She won more than \$200,000 and was a stakes winner before Dalos bought her from his daughter. Gambling Girl is the dam of the family's graded stakes winner Gamble's Ghost (by Ghostzapper), a top mare in 2017.

Following the 2016 Sovereign Awards, in which 11 Dalos horses were up for awards, his breeding program will be well represented at the 2017 awards ceremony April 19 at Woodbine Racetrack.

Ami's Mesa is a shoo-in for champion female sprinter and likely champion older female, and she will battle Pink Lloyd for Horse of the Year honors.

Channel Maker, an English Channel 3-year-old out of the nowdeceased In Return (by Horse Chestnut), sold as a yearling by Dalos, could be named the year's best sophomore male as well as champion turf male. His full brother, Johnny Bear, the 2012 sales-topper at Woodbine at \$325,000, won the Northern Dancer Turf Stakes (G1T) at Woodbine in 2017 and is also up for champion turf male.

Dalos could very well win his first Sovereign for outstanding breeder as he bred the earners of more than \$2.3 million on the year.

Dalos' own runners won 17 races in 2017, more than any other year, and earned nearly \$1.3 million.

"I try to breed every horse to the best of my ability and by what I can afford," said Dalos, 76. "I breed every horse as if I am going to race it, too. But I have to sell some."

Dalos has 20 mares this year plus 14 juveniles in training. Josie Carroll, trainer of Ami's Mesa, is his main conditioner. Mike DePaulo also trained for him in 2017.

Ami's Mesa has returned to training in Florida and will be pointed toward another run at the Breeders' Cup, this year to be held at Churchill Downs.

to attend the awards ceremony in April. Irene suffered a stroke in mid-January and Dalos has put everything horse-related on hold while he stays with his wife through rehabilitation.

"I love the sport, and I love the animals; that's why I am in the business," said Dalos. "But my wife is my focus right now. I started Tall Oaks for her and my daughters."
