Quite a View

Bob and Bonnie Roth are taking Majestic View Farms commercial

NEARLY 20 YEARS AGO Bob and Bonnie Roth happened to drive past Blue Chip Farm, located outside Gardiner, north of New York City. One of the premier Standardbred racing and breeding operations in the United States, it wasn't far from where the Roths, Long Island natives, had moved, and from where Bonnie had grown up after her parents had moved north.

"It was a beautiful piece of land," Bonnie remembered, "and every time we'd come to Gardiner we'd go look at it."

As she recalls, one day when they were looking at the farm, Bob learned it was for sale. He walked back to where Bonnie was standing and said, "Bonnie, we're going to own a farm."

Her reaction?

"I said, 'Good!' " she exclaimed, that initial delight still in her voice. Her parents had moved to the area when she was in high school, and Bob would make the trip from Long Island to see her on weekends. After they were married, they moved back to Long Island but succumbed to the lure of the country before long.

Bob had begun riding horses when he was 8 years old, and he continued to ride when the Roths moved upstate. The first horses on their farm were Peruvians; continuing the Blue Chip tradition, the land the Roths named Majestic View Farms also housed Standardbreds. Several years ago the Thoroughbreds arrived.

"My husband has always loved Thoroughbreds," said Bonnie. "I call them the Cadillac of horses."

Unlike many other people who get involved in the Thoroughbred industry, the Roths previously had little interest in

racing; they went to the races occasionally, and, according to Bob, one of the reasons they decided to embark on the venture was because they thought it "would be fun" to go to Kentucky for the Bluegrass Thoroughbred experience.

Working full-time and owning a farm, however, didn't leave much time for that; Bob is vice-president of a company that manufactures and packages a wide array of private-label cosmetics and personal care products, and on a morning in early February, he was unable to come to the phone because he was outside shoveling snow. The farm boards a couple of dozen

mares and houses two stallions—Make Reservations and Trickmeister. The Roths hired Jaime Martin, a veteran of both the racetrack and a breeding farm, to oversee Majestic View Farms' equine operations, and, said Bob, they pretty much leave all the details to him.

"Bonnie does all the paperwork," Bob said. "I run the financial end, and Jaime and Beth handle the day-to-day operations. We're like a family. We're very close to both of them, and it all works."

The farm's assistant manager, Beth Sickler, came to Majestic View Farms after a stint at Dutchess Views Farm near Pine Plains, N.Y. She grew up in the Hudson Valley, loved riding, and pursued a career as a jockey at the North American Racing Academy in Lexington. After a bad gate accident, she decided life as a jockey was not what she wanted, and she got a job at Dutchess Views, where she learned how to work with babies and was told her quiet demeanor made her a natural to work with mares and foals.

"I like seeing when they're born and seeing them grow up and go off to start their careers," said Sickler. "If they do well, I think back: 'I was there when that foal was born, that one had a hard time, that one's ankles were down.' I think about feeding them every hour for three days and then see them as yearlings, as perfect as perfect can be."

While at Dutchess Views, Sickler worked in the barn and in the breeding shed, trained in vaccinations and foaling, and learned the office side of a breeding operation. It was there that she met Martin, who was the farm manager at the time.

Dutchess Views was Martin's final stop before Majestic View after working at a number of New York farms. He began his career in racing in California, where he was an exercise rider at Hollywood Park and Santa Anita. The Roths hired

him two years ago.

The farm is home to about 70 horses, including yearlings, broodmares, and 2-year-olds, owned by the Roths and clients, whom Martin requires keep their mares at the farm year-round.

Martin recently purchased two mares for the Roths. Them There Eyes is a multiple New York-bred stakes-winning mare bred by the late John Hettinger at his Akindale Farm. By Holy Bull out of the D'Accord mare So Long Dearie, Them There Eyes earned \$289,300 and is a half sister to My Dinah, a multiple stakes winner with earnings of more than \$450,000, and to Cayo Hueso, who earned more than \$250,000.

Them There Eyes' most successful offspring so far is the 2011 Grand Slam gelding Balderdash who earned \$118,354. She has a Big Brown yearling filly named Big Brown Eyes and will be bred this year to Central Banker, who stands at McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds near Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

Joining Them There Eyes is Prairie Trip, an 11-year-old Florida-bred mare by Trippi out of Prairie View (by Honor Grades), who earned \$174,959 in 56 starts. She is in foal to Dutchess Views Farm stallion Bellamy Road.

"She didn't win any stakes races," said Martin, "but I like her endurance."

He expects to buy two or three more mares for the Roths this year. As Majestic View will be a commercial breeder, Martin is looking at Kentucky- or New York-bred broodmares in foal to Kentucky stallions,

even as he supports New York stallions with the farm's current mares.

"I rely on Jaime," said Bob Roth. "He's more knowledeaable about horses than I will ever be."

"He's taken us to a new level," added



Bonnie. "We're really proud and happy to have him with us."

The farm currently supports itself with the boarding fees paid by outside clients, and Martin hopes to create a program that will stay small enough to be manageable while big enough to be profitable.

"I don't want to overdo it with boarding mares," he said. "I want the farm and the grass to look nice, but we've got to treat the farm like a business. We can't keep all the foals."

And that's the hard part for Bonnie Roth, particularly when the foals that are arriving belong to other people.

"One day Bob came into the breakfast room and I was sitting there, looking out at the farm and crying," she said. "'Why are you crying?' he asked.

"'Look at these babies,' "I said. "'They've only known Majestic View Farms, and I've known them since they were conceived. They know me.'

"He said, 'Bonnie, I don't know how to break this to you, but I can't buy all of them!'"

She laughed.

"He told me not to get so close to them," she said. "But I feel like they're mine, and I love my animals."

And soon Bonnie will have a number of foals to call her own—at least temporarily—out of her and Bob's mares and by their stallions. They purchased Kentucky-bred winner Trickmeister (Proud Citizen—Afternoon Trick, by Afternoon Deelites) and Make Reservations (Tapit—Formal Reception, by Unbridled), who made only one start, finishing second, his career cut short by injury.

"We started to board Thoroughbreds after Jaime came to the farm," said Bonnie. "That's when Bob said to him, 'If you ever see anything you think I'd be interested in, let me know."

"Make Reservations couldn't prove himself on the track because he got hurt," she added. "But we think with Tapit and Unbridled in his bloodlines, he's going to be a good stallion."

As part of their renovation and development of the farm, the Roths have added what Bonnie called a "state-of-the-art" stallion barn and lab and renovated all

the existing barns. To protect and enlarge Majestic View, they've added available land that abuts their original purchase.

In some ways, getting involved with

Thoroughbreds was nearly an afterthought for the Roths, a small part of their overall farm experience. They speak about their Gardiner home, where they live fulltime, with a joy that approaches reverence.

"We live just below the mountain, and it's just gorgeous," said Bob. "It's very spiritual to me."

"I love every minute of it," echoed Bonnie. But they've also immersed themselves in their new business, with Martin making strategic, prudent purchases instead of rushing in with a huge investment.

"I don't want to go out and spend a lot of money all at once," he said. "I want us to be in business for a long time."

Bonnie recalled a trip to Saratoga Race Course with Bob, and she remembered his saying, as he looked out at the track, "I'd just love to see a horse of mine out there."

And with New York-bred foals sired by New York-based stallions, if all goes well, that might well happen, as soon as next year.
