

IF ASKED TO NAME A STATE known for horse racing, few would mention Arizona. Although Turf Paradise outside Phoenix runs for parts of eight months a year, the state does not host a graded stakes race for Thoroughbreds or Quarter Horses. Yet, at a dusty bullring track in Tucson, racing is alive, and is starting to make waves. In the shadows of the Santa Catalina Mountains sits Rillito Park, a historic landmark that has survived decades of adversity to become the epitome of resolve, a learning laboratory for the next generation of racing leaders, and the embodiment of the live racetrack experience.

Rillito, built in 1943, has long been known as the birthplace of modern Quarter Horse racing. The venue, home to the first three-eighths-mile straightaway, or "chute," did not host Thoroughbred racing until 1953, when the current fiveeighths oval was constructed. Hall-of-Famers Ismael "Milo" Valenzuela and Bob Baffert both rode at Rillito, with Baffert fortuitously switching careers and

recording his first Thoroughbred training victory at the track in 1979.

Despite its impressive credentials Rillito has faced uncertainty throughout its history. Closed for much of the 1980s, fair racing returned to the track under the direction of the Pima County Horsemen's Association, keeping racing alive through the 1990s and early 2000s.

The 21st century brought a new threat: soccer. The racetrack's infield contains four soccer fields, and another seven lie outside the oval within a corner kick of the far turn. A 2006 resolution called for the demolition of the track and grandstand to add more fields. Fortunately for the racing community, the funds for the project were never raised. In 2017 the Pima County Board of Supervisors voted to extend the lease for racing to continue at Rillito through 2021, rescuing the historic venue from being razed.

Given the track's unsettled history and aged facility, creating excitement and local traction for a race meet at Rillito could have proved to be a futile effort. Enter Mike Weiss.

Weiss, 61, has been involved in horse racing for more than 40 years. He has worked in countless positions in the industry, but he is perhaps best known for

his role at Beulah Park, where he served as executive vice president and general manager for 14 years.

Known for his innovative ideas, Weiss introduced the Beulah handicapping twin sisters and the Fortune 6 bet (now known as the Rainbow 6), and he was the first director of racing to use Equibase past performances. The former executive vice president and general manager of AmericaTab, an advanced deposit wagering platform that was purchased by Churchill Downs Inc., Weiss now runs a consulting business and is the president of the ADW PariBet.

However, it was Weiss' success in bring-

ing racing back to the North Dakota Horse Park that eventually led him to Tucson.

"I had a call from the North Dakota Racing Commission one day saying this track had been closed for three years, and the horsemen were trying to put together a meet, and they asked if I would fly to a meeting there," Weiss said. "I went out to North Dakota for the meeting, and, afterward, I literally flew home, packed a bag, and came back to North Dakota for six weeks on my own dime just to open that place."

Weiss' time in North Dakota attracted the interest of the Rillito Park Foundation, a 501(c)(3) created to oversee the Rillito

land, which includes the racetrack and soccer fields, a farmers' market, public parks, and the J. Rukin Jelks Stud Farm, a historic Quarter Horse farm. Weiss became the general manager of Rillito for the 2015 meet and has returned every year

Since taking control of operations, Weiss has overseen the installation of a new dirt surface, upgrades in concessions and entertainment, and a partnership with the University of Arizona's Race Track Industry Program.

"I didn't expect to be here this many years," said Weiss. "But everything started happening with the students, and I started getting some real satisfaction out of it, and it's hard to walk away."

Weiss is specifically referring to the PariBet Racetrack Industry Student Experience (PRISE), a program he sponsors that enables students in the RTIP to work in a variety of roles at Rillito. In these positions students gain the skills necessary to work at a racetrack while interacting with the public and educating attendees about horse racing.

The RTIP has churned out hundreds of enthusiastic employees for the racing industry over the years, including Weiss.

Thus, it should come as no surprise that when Weiss walked into the RTIP offices to interview a room full of students, he found an eager group that hoped he would give them the opportunity to work at Rillito.

"Some came in very nervous like it was a first job interview. I would say, 'Relax, have a cookie, and tell me about you. The fact that you showed up today means you have a job!"

The list of jobs filled by students each year reaches to all corners of racing operations: racing office, track handicapping, photo finish operations, graphics, clocking, mutuels, social media, grooming, ponying, and more. At Rillito Park, it is almost impossible not to see or directly engage with a student involved with PRISE.

Comparing the working experience at a small track such as Rillito to a larger

racetrack, Weiss noted, "It's the same game with different numbers. We're missing a couple of zeros at the end of our purses. It doesn't matter if you run six days or 120 days, you still have to be prepared in the same way. Your racing surface has to be safe for the athletes. The racing office, accounting, concessions, admissions, parking, security, marketing, and social media—everything still has to be in place."

However, Rillito's smaller size lends itself to a true hands-on experience.

"We don't have all of the layers of people," Weiss said. "If you're involved, you're involved, whether you're taking an entry or running out to rake the paddock because we just had a quick rain. You become a team and a family, and you get your hands dirty."

"I think having a racetrack right there by the university and getting the firsthand experience is really great for the students," said Erin Doty-McQuaid, an RTIP graduate who worked the 2018 meet as Rillito's program manager and is now the assistant program coordinator and administrative

assistant for the Racing Officials Accreditation Program. "If you can work at a place such as Rillito and make it work, I think you can do it anywhere."

Executives from Breeders' Cup reached out to Weiss after learning about his program at Rillito. Through PRISE, Weiss sponsored trips for RTIP students to work at the Breeders' Cup in 2017 and 2018.

Dr. Shane Burgess, the Charles-Sander Dean of the University of Arizona's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, has seen the benefits of students' working at the track firsthand. The college is in the midst of formalizing a partnership with the Rillito Park Foundation so students in the college can participate in paid internship opportunities spanning all aspects of Rillito Park, from the racetrack to the farmers' market.

"One of the things about Rillito that is really good is that the students get an integrated view of how the whole system runs," Burgess said. "People often look at the size of the budget, but the size of the budget has nothing to do with the complexity. You've got an organization here that has all of the complexity that exists anywhere

else, and yet it's small enough for you to get your arms and your mind around it. And because of its size, the students are comfortable there. It's a good atmosphere for people to learn in."

Yet, Rillito is more than a classroom. Its race cards may be anchored by \$2,000 claimers and \$5,000 stakes races, but Weiss

describes the atmosphere as "amazing."

"Every day is like a big race day at a larger track. You can have a 1-9 shot turning for home, 10 lengths in front, and the whole clubhouse is erupting and waving their tickets. They're screaming like it's American Pharoah coming down the stretch," Weiss said. "The demographics at

Fans pack the paddock area

Rillito are better than at any track I've ever been to. You have a mix of all ages from college students to the typical older demographic. You have 120 tables in the clubhouse that are sold out every day, and then you go out into the grandstand, and you put a mariachi band out there, and you'll have 1,000 people in a big circle dancing in between races. It is just so much fun."

The excitement sounds contagious, but does such a small track create racing fans?

Scott Little would answer that question with an emphatic "yes." Little worked in the hospitality industry for more than 25 years before he decided to follow his passion and attend the RTIP. He worked two racing seasons at Rillito while living in Tucson and served as the assistant general manager in 2018. His hospitality roots have never left him, and Little spent parts of race days walking among the crowd to see if he could assist customers.

"There was a lady that got to the track

way before the first race, and I heard her talking to somebody and saying that she had never been here and was not sure what to do," Little said. "I just decided to strike up a conversation with her, and I was sitting with her for 15 minutes going over the program. Her friend showed up later, and I saw them at a table in the clubhouse right down on the glass. I talked to them at least three or four more times throughout the rest of the year."

In another fortuitous meeting, Little hooked his downstairs neighbors on horse racing.

"I ran into them one day when they were driving by Rillito. They had never been, and they saw me and wanted to know what I was doing there. This was in early February before the first day of the meet, and I gave them a couple of passes to come check it out."

Little's neighbors ended up buying a table for the entire season.

Now a product manager for AmTote and based in Maryland, Little noted that his wife, who still lives in Tucson, reports that those neighbors have told her that they are looking forward to going back to Rillito in 2019.

Unfortunately, enthusiasm does not pay the bills.

"With the crowds we get, we show we can make money during the season," said Weiss. "However, racing has a lot of expenses, and we definitely need some benefactors to help keep this program alive."

In 2018 Rillito hosted 12 days of Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse racing during February and March, and 12 days are planned in 2019. With increased funding, Weiss would like to run 20 days of live racing at Rillito in future years.

Should the racing industry choose to support selected small racetracks such as Rillito, it will be able to ensure that new fans have the opportunity to attend the races and longtime fans are able to sustain their passion. This year The Jockey Club commissioned McKinsey & Company to conduct a current analysis of the Thoroughbred industry and fan development, the results of which were presented at The Jockey Club's annual Round Table Conference on Matters Pertaining to Racing, held this summer in Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

Among the McKinsey team's findings was that more than 60% of surveyed fans stated that the most significant factor in their becoming a fan was going to the racetrack with their family or friends. Based on this data, Stuart S. Janney III, the chairman of TJC, concluded this year's Round Table by announcing the organiza-

tion's intent to consider ownership of racetracks in important markets.

"We have done a great job with increasing television coverage through TVG and national network broadcasts and getting the word out about the sport using websites and social media through initiatives such as America's Best Racing," said James L. Gagliano, president and chief operating officer of TJC. "However, when race fans reflect on their early interest in horse racing, it more than likely came from trips to the track with friends and family. We believe that having major league and minor league tracks is necessary to sustain a national sport."

As those who have visited or worked at Rillito can attest, it is not the size of the purses or the facility that makes a racing fan. It is the experience.

"There are people who have looked at me, and they go, 'What are you doing? Why are you at Rillito?' "Weiss said.

His response?

"You don't get it. You have to come see it and feel it."

For the sake of horse racing, let us hope that new fans can be exposed to that feeling for years to come. BH
