

on the outskirts of the Lone Star State's largest city is hoping for a revolution—or more accurately, a revival—of its own.

One of three Class 1 tracks in Texas, along with Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie near Dallas-Ft. Worth and Retama Park outside of San Antonio, Sam Houston celebrated its 25th anniversary season in 2019, but at that milestone the track's racing product was more mediocre than majestic. Purses for maiden special weight and allowance races were around \$20,000, and bottom-level pots barely cracked the \$6,000 mark.

Then, after years of unsuccessful attempts by Texas racing interests at legalizing slot machines, video lottery terminals, and historical horse racing machines, House Bill 2463 passed the Texas Legislature and went into effect on Sept. 1, 2019. On the surface the bill sounded

somewhat mundane as it put into escrow a portion of state taxes collected on a variety of equine-related goods and services. But the reality is that the escrow means up to \$25 million annually that racetracks and breed associations can use for enhanced purses, breeding incentives, and marketing initiatives. It provided a much-needed boost for racing and breeding industries in Texas, which is surrounded by states with additional gaming at their racetracks. The bill has produced a positive outlook in

Texas for both horsemen and racetracks, rising to a level perhaps not felt since Lone Star Park hosted the Breeders' Cup World Championships in 2004.

WEATHERING THE STORM

When Sam Houston kicked off its 2020 meet in January—the first Texas meet since HB 2463 passed—maiden special weight and allowance contests had been increased to more than \$35,000, and all signs were pointing to a successful meet. Then, of course, COVID-19 hit. Sam Houston was forced to cancel the last four days of the meet in March due to the pandemic, and the track also lost most of a fifth date when Texas Champions Day, with seven stakes for Texas-breds, had to be scrapped due to a blown transformer on what ended up being the final day of the abbreviated stand.

Despite an abrupt ending to the Thoroughbred meet and the cancellation of its entire American Quarter Horse meet set for the spring, the track still laid the groundwork for future success.

"We were having a really good meet and were up 39% in handle year-over-year, and then the carpet got pulled out," said Dwight Berube, the track's vice president and general manager.

Now the track is set to open its 2021 Thoroughbred meet Jan. 8 and run

through April 3 with the specter of COVID-19 still looming but also a newfound hope for the coming years and a renewed focus on its core product.

"We are not sure what's down the road with COVID; nobody knows," said Berube. "But you still have to plan for the meet, and we have plans in place, but at the very least we assume the current restrictions will still be in place when we open. We have our fingers crossed things don't get worse."

In a state that does not allow for wagering to occur anywhere other than in-person at racetracks-no ADW, no off-track betting-Sam Houston sat idle for more than two months during the early stages of the pandemic. But once the track reopened for simulcasting, things took a turn for the better.

"The simulcast handle has been excel-(continued on page 48)



Louisiana's New Non-Resident Mare Rule Offers More Opportunities

The Louisiana Thoroughbred Breeders Association has recently modified the by-laws allowing for a new "Non-Resident Mare" to be eligible to have accredited Louisiana bred foals. The Non-Resident section of the by-law reads:

(b) Non-Resident Mare is a broodmare that arrives in Louisiana in foal and after foaling must be covered by a Louisiana domiciled stallion in that foaling year, and pregnant or not, must remain in Louisiana for a period of ninety (90) days after foaling or until August 1 of the foaling year, whichever is earlier.

With this by-law change, breeders may be able to be a significant part of the Louisiana Breeders program and be rewarded accordingly.

lent since we reopened on June 3 after being shut down for 21/2 months," added Berube. "And since we reopened, we are actually surpassing last year's numbers."

Now the test will be to keep that momentum going for the live racing meet, and early indications are good with new trainers and horses being attracted by more race dates, higher purses, and renowned racing surfaces, especially the turf course.

Berube expects overnight purses to average around \$215,000 per day over the 46-day meet.

"Our total purse pool should be in the \$12-million range for the Thoroughbred meet," he said. "Last (meet) was incomplete, but in 2019 I think our total Thoroughbred purses were around \$4.2 million."

The increased purses have made the job of Frank Hopf, senior director of racing operations, a little bit easier, at least when it comes to filling stalls.

"We got 2,300 stall apps for a barn area of 1,130," he said. "We had about 40 new

trainers apply for stalls this year. We've had some from around this region but also Kentucky and some even from Minnesota, Florida, New Mexico, and Washington. Really all parts of the country.

"The last two years have been a lot different than the first three years in this role for me for stall allocation," he added.

In addition to a bulked-up overnight purse structure, Sam Houston will be offering more race days in 2021-46 compared to 39 scheduled (and 34 completed) last meet. The 2021 stakes schedule totals \$2.4 million, up from \$1.8 million originally set for last time around.

The showpiece of the stakes schedule will be the Houston Racing Festival Jan. 31, featuring the track's two grade 3 events, the \$300,000 Houston Ladies Classic and \$200,000 John B. Connally Turf Cup.

While the 11/2-mile Connally has been the track's richest and most important turf stakes since the first running in 1995, the Houston Ladies Classic, for 4-year-old and older fillies and mares at 11/16 miles on the main track, took over the mantle as the track's top race when it was inaugurated in 2013. Its short list of winners already includes Midnight Bisou, who kicked off her 2019 campaign with a victory at Sam Houston en route to an Eclipse Award for champion older dirt female. And the 2020 renewal attracted the prior year's Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner Serengeti

Empress, who was upset by the Steve Asmussen-trained Lady Apple.

"We've been fortunate the last couple of years with some big horses coming through here," said Hopf. "We are already getting a lot of interest in the race (in 2021), and we hope that it will earn grade 2 status soon."

MORE MONEY, MORE COMPETITION

The flip side of higher purses is that some horsemen will be left without the stalls they requested, and the quality of competition on the track figures to be tougher than at any time in recent memory at Sam Houston.

One trainer who is up for the challenge is Mindy Willis, a longtime fixture at the track and around the region.

"It's nice to have new people come in," said Willis, who finished fifth by earnings in the trainer standings for the 2020

Sam Houston meet. "The people that have been there for years will have to realize that when purses get better, the horses get better and you have to upgrade. I've never been worried about that. It just makes you step up to the plate and compete."

Among the expected newcomers to Sam Houston for the 2021 meet is Brad Cox, fresh off a four-victory performance at the Breeders' Cup World Championships. He'll join a deep pool of conditioners, where last meet's top four earners were Asmussen, Karl Broberg, Bret Calhoun, and Danny Pish.

"The surfaces are great, and the grass is second to none," opined Willis. "When

those big guys come in for the major turf races, they see what a good course it is."

Indeed, the Cox stable got to see the turf course first-hand when Dot Matrix won the 2020 Connally Turf, snapping an incredible run of six consecutive wins in the race by trainer Mike Maker, including the 2017-19 runnings with Bigger Picture.

Seeking to capitalize on the reputation of its grass course, Sam Houston introduced the \$200,000 Texas Turf Mile for 3-year-olds for the 2020 meet, and it will again be part of the Houston Racing Festival with more than \$1 million in total purses that day.

HOPE FOR MORE TEXAS-BREDS

When Texas hosted the Breeders' Cup in 2004, more than 3,000 mares were bred in the state and the state's number of stallions reached nearly 400. Even considering the contraction of annual foal crops nationwide, the decline of Texas' breeding program since then has been staggering-according to the latest figures from The Jockey Club, just 415 mares were bred in 2019 with 87 stallions on the books. The Texas foal crop numbered more than 2,000 at the start of this century, and for 2019 it is projected to be 271. Despite those dire numbers, there is a glimmer of hope.

"We want to help start building the Texas breeding program back and improving that," said Hopf. "So we think a better Texas-bred stakes schedule can be part of that."

To that end, Sam Houston's stakes schedule includes 14 events for Texas-bred or Texas-sired horses, and the seven stakes that constitute Texas Champions Day will be worth \$100,000 apiece, double the value in 2019.

"I've got clients looking for Texas-breds now," said Willis. "For a while no one was breeding much in Texas because the purses weren't much, but now people are starting to breed again."

"We've had more calls about accreditation, and we've had some new stallions coming in this year," added Mary Ruyle, executive director of the Texas Thoroughbred Association.

It's too early to tell whether the anecdotal increase in interest will translate to more Texas-bred foals, especially given the uncertainty of a health pandemic, but there was enough interest from area buyers and consignors for the TTA to bring back a winter mixed sale this December, the first of its kind in nearly a decade. The TTA and Lone Star Park already operate a 2-year-olds in training and a yearling sale

While any new Texas-bred foals figure to have more money to run at in the state, breeders can now earn awards when those horses win races out of state. Using some of the money from the escrow fund, the TTA this year launched a new bonus program that pays breeders when their Texas-breds hit the board in races anywhere in the U.S.,

provided that there's not a live meet currently running in Texas (and \$50,000 and up stakes are eligible for awards at any

time). And to offer an additional incentive, breeder awards are also now being paid for Texasbreds that hit the board against open company within the state of Texas.

MORE FOCUS ON RACING

Like many other tracksespecially those without revenue from other types of gaming-Sam Houston has expanded its entertainment menu to include concerts and other types of "racing," such as wiener dogs, ostriches, and the like.

Berube said that concerts are out for the 2021 meet, for obvious reasons, and that other on-track promotions are likely to be scaled back.

"We are planning to do wiener dogs and camel and ostrich racing, but with COVID we've cut back on those types of promotions outside of racing," he said. "We are definitely focused on racing this year."

The track's schedule will offer afternoon racing on Thursdays in January, with

Wednesday afternoon racing being added starting in February. Friday and Saturday racing will be in the evenings, save for the lone Sunday afternoon program on Jan. 31 with the Houston Racing Festival.

Using funds from the escrow account, the track is planning to promote its simulcast signal on TVG and with marketing through industry publications, websites, and radio/satellite shows. With solid field sizes anticipated, thanks to a full back-

> side and more nationally recognized trainers running at Sam Houston, the track's simulcast signal should be attractive to bettors, especially with a 4 p.m. Central post on Wednesdays and Thursdays against somewhat limited competition.

> For Berube, who has been at Sam Houston for more than 25 years, it's been a long time coming for the track and for Texas racing.

"I was here for the original construction of the track, so I

go way back," he said. "Without question, this is the most exciting time I remember in Texas racing." BH
