Golden Pal's Sunshine State Start

AFTER SAVING LADY SHIPMAN, RYAN BARBAZON ALSO WELCOMED HER FIRST FOAL

R ANDY LOWE REALLY hadn't planned on Lady Shipman's delivering a Florida-bred.


The breeder/owner simply knew he had a special mare, and he didn't want to disrupt the routine of sending his dams-to-be to Ryan Barbazon. After all, long before Lady Shipman won 11 stakes, ran second against males in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (G1T), and set a course record at Saratoga Race Course, Barbazon had saved her life when she was foaled.

So, with Lady Shipman starting her career as a broodmare and Barbazon having traded in Kentucky winters for Florida sunshine, Lowe sent her to Ocala, Fla., following her successful date with renowned sire Uncle Mo. A colt—Lady Shipman's first foal—hit the ground Feb. 23, 2018.

Lowe knew what he wanted in a sire before he sent Lady Shipman to Uncle Mo.

"I looked at all the stallions that were around the whole country, and Uncle Mo can throw a dirt (horse), as well as a grass (horse). He throws runners," Lowe said. "He's a real big horse, and I looked at horses that produce (on the track) and run when they're early on; who did well as a 2-year-old."

"I also figured Lady Shipman could pass on her speed."

Breeders' Cup races.

"If Pal wins the Breeders' Cup for the third time, he will be the first male horse in history to win three Breeders' Cups," Lowe said. "The reason why is, most of the horses, after you win a couple of Breeders' Cups, they're gone. They're in the breeding shed."

Barbazon did not sound surprised at Golden Pal's accomplishments.

"If you had to draw a horse on paper and say, 'This is what I want the physicals to look like,' he has them," Barbazon said. "He's beautiful in every aspect. He's very well-proportioned, very well-balanced—what we were praying for when we did the cross."

Golden Pal went back into training under Wesley Ward in late December with connections eyeing the Shakertown Stakes (G2T) at Keeneland in April for his 4-year-old season debut. Through eight starts, the bay colt is 5-2-0.

Golden Pal, then racing for Lowe's Ranlo Investments, won the

2020 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint (G2T) at Keeneland. Ahead of his 3-year-old season, the colt sold to Coolmore-affiliated Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith, and Georg Von Opel's racing operation Westerberg. Lowe did retain breeding rights. For his new owners, Golden Pal delivered a victory in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (G1T) last year at Del Mar.

Lowe still owns Lady Shipman, who is expected to deliver a full sister to Golden Pal this year. Lady Shipman went 13-2-2 in 21 starts, including a runner-up finish by a neck to Mongolian Saturday in the 2015 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Keeneland.

"People used to tell me she's the horse of a lifetime," Lowe said. "If she's the horse of a lifetime, what does that make Golden Pal?"

Lowe has signed a contract to send the

11-time stakes-winning mare to Godolphin's two-time champion Essential Quality—winner of the Claiborne Breeders' Futurity, TVG Breeders' Cup Juvenile Presented by Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance, Belmont Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets, and Runhappy Travers Stakes (all G1). Essential Quality is in his first season at stud at Darley.

"Lady Shipman is a mare that is very near and dear to our hearts as she is from Midshipman's first crop and is one of his best, flying the flag for him for a number of years," said Darley stallions sales manager Darren Fox, adding that it's an attractive pairing with Essential Quality. "With Golden Pal as her first foal, she could not have made a better start to her broodmare career and is a major coup for any stallion and is especially key for one about to cover his first mares."

Lady Shipman resides at Tom VanMeter's Stockplace Farm

near Lexington.

"There isn't another mare in Kentucky worth what this mare is worth financially and emotionally for Mr. Lowe," VanMeter said.

Lady Shipman's second foal, a chestnut son of the War Front colt Omaha Beach, also is on VanMeter's farm. His name is Lieutenant General.

"He is the spitting image of his mother," VanMeter said. "He is a clone of his mother's temperament and shape. He looks exactly like her. There's not one drop of paint that's different.

"He is an A-plus physical; the mare is an A-plus physical."

Those early reports about Lieutenant General have Lowe dreaming big.

"I honestly believe, if I keep him, I think we'll win the Breeders' Cup with him as well," said Lowe, who acknowledged he's already receiving offers for the colt.

Times have changed for Lowe, who took Lady Shipman and

Golden Pal to sales only to keep them after reserve prices were not met. VanMeter was referred to Lowe by Barbazon, who now owns Barbazon Racing & Bloodstock with wife, Rebecca.

Barbazon earned Lowe's trust by the way he had taken care of Lady Shipman's dam, Sumthingtotalkabt.

Michelle Dollase, daughter of trainer Wally Dollase, sent the mare to Barbazon. "They couldn't get her pregnant, and I had a fair reputation of taking the troubled mares and getting them pregnant," Barbazon said. "I got her, got her covered, got her bred. I had her in foal every year until she was sold.

"She was a high-maintenance mare, trouble staying in foal. Had to be P&E (progesterone and estrogen therapy). Soft-footed, always had to have some TLC."

Barbazon considers Lady Shipman a high-maintenance filly. She nearly did not survive her own birth.

"She was born dead; she was a stillborn in my hands," Barbazon said. "I ended up doing CPR on Lady Shipman for about 45 seconds until she kicked me in the chest.

"The bond and affection with that whole family started there. And to see her do what she did, and the first foal do what it's done, it's kinda like, 'If you had waited for a vet that night, none of this would have happened."

Lowe, a former Redondo Beach, Calif., police officer and commercial insurance agent, also owns Talkin Pharoah, a son of American Pharoah. The colt is out of Just Talkin, a full sister to Lady Shipman and

also bred by Lowe.

"American Pharoah was one of the horses I was considering for Lady Shipman," Lowe said.

Lowe had gone back to Midshipman

with Sumthingtotalkabt, who foaled Just Talkin in 2013. The full sister to Lady Shipman was sold to Michael Dubb and went 3-4-3 in 15 career starts.

Dubb sold Just Talkin to David Fennelly's Mountmellick Farm for \$675,000 at the 2019 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Mixed Sale. Talkin Pharoah, a 2-yearold chestnut, was bred by Mountmellick Farm. Bringing things full circle, Lowe then purchased Talkin Pharoah for \$260,000 at the 2021 Keeneland September yearling sale, with Ward signing the ticket. This year the now-juvenile colt was sent to Ward at Payson Park.

"They're looking at me to prove the stallion, and I already got the proven side on the Lady Shipman side," Lowe said. "Now we're trying to prove the Just Talkin side."
