INDA MADSEN CONSTANTLY LOOKS FOR stallions with bloodlines she thinks will do well in California and stands them at her Milky Way Farm in Temecula. But she never thought she'd be able to attract a horse such as Midnight Storm.

"We're trying to bring in a new good stud every year," Madsen said. "We try to bring in a different kind of pedigree because not everyone likes the same kind of horse. It gives us a nice variety."

For the 2020 breeding season, Madsen had imported Graydar, a grade 1-winning son of Unbridled's Song, to California from Taylor Made Stallions in Kentucky after he was already siring winners. That proved so popular— Graydar still stands at Milky Way—that she was able to do the same thing for 2023 with Midnight Storm, who also had stood at Taylor Made.

In a way, Midnight Storm was returning home by stand-

ing at Milky Way. He spent his entire racing career in California and descends from roots in the Golden State. Alex Venneri and Marjorie Post Dye bred the son of Pioneerof the Nile in

Kentucky from their California-bred mare My Tina, a daughter of Cal-bred champion Bertrando.

Midnight Storm began racing in 2014 for Venneri and Dye, and

for most of his career Phil D'Amato trained him. Little Red Feather joined in owning the colt after he won the 2014 Del Mar Derby (G2T). Dye passed away in 2015, and for Venneri and Little Red Feather, Midnight Storm went on to score in such races as the 2016 Shoemaker Mile (G1T). He also finished third in that year's Breeders' Cup Mile (G1T), ultimately earning \$1,783,110 in his career.

With two crops to race, Midnight Storm has already gotten such runners as Great Escape, who won the 2022 Canadian Derby (G3) at Century Mile. In that race, Great Escape set a track record of 2:01.35 for 1¼ miles, and he

has placed in three other stakes.

Midnight Storm joins the other stallions at the Milky Way property where Madsen's family has raised horses since 1967. Her parents, Leland and Esther May Mekeel, initially raised champion Arabians on the farm, and Madsen grew up showing the family horses. Madsen's late husband, Larry Seeman, was the veterinarian for many Thoroughbred farms in the area during the 1980s. While Madsen has also successfully shown cattle and still breeds and raises Guernsey calves, she now concentrates on Thoroughbred breeding.

In keeping the busy farm going today Madsen credits a top-notch staff. Milky Way farm manager Johnny Alvira plays a crucial role in every facet of the operation. Many of Alvira's family members also work at Milky Way.

"He's so important on the ranch," Madsen said. "He's just a wonderful guy. His grandfather works here—he's our night man. Johnny basically grew up here. He's been so involved with the farm. I'm just the luckiest person in the world to have him."

Relatively new to Milky Way is Dr. Celeste Martin, who handles the veterinary work. Martin is in the process of establishing an office at the farm. She is from California, but spent time in Kentucky that included an internship at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital.

Bloodstock agent Gayle Van Leer for many years has helped Madsen acquire mares and continues in that role. Madsen and her friend Joy Seifert partner on the mares and own about 50, having purchased many of them in Kentucky. Madsen said they have 10 by Giant's Causeway and six by Medaglia d'Oro.

Hollywood Queen is one of the Giant's Causeway mares Van Leer bought for them. The mare cost \$35,000 at the 2016 Keeneland January horses of all ages sale. Hollywood Queen's half brother, Roy H, won back-to-back editions of the Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) in 2017-18 and twice earned an Eclipse Award as champion male sprinter. Hollywood Queen's runners include She's a Joker, a 2019

Cal-bred daughter of Practical Joke who in 2022 earned \$112,772.

In recent years, Milky Way has started acting as agent in selling horses, both for the farm and for some clients. Madsen and Alvira have incorporated that end of the business into improvements Madsen has made to Milky Way.

"We took our long barn and made a big walking area like they have in Kentucky," Madsen said. "They prepare the yearlings in that barn in the summer. Johnny runs the agency, and we've done really well with it. We sold some for George Krikorian this past year."

They also built a showing area for the stallions, updated the foaling barn, and refurbished two barns that previously had been leased to an Arabian trainer. Madsen and Alvira need all of the facilities on the 100-acre farm these days because of the volume of business. Madsen said they bred 220 mares in 2022 and foaled 130 babies.

Madsen and Seifert market almost everything they breed from their broodmare band. Occasionally, they will keep a daughter to continue a bloodline.

Milky Way is located near several other horse farms. The California Ranch Company, which offers many Western equine activities, is virtually next door, while San Luis Rey Downs and Galway Downs are nearby. Madsen is active in the local equine community, having served as an officer on the board of the California Farm Managers Association.

Madsen has partnered with the farm managers and the California Thoroughbred Breeders Association to host stallion tours. Such tours often start and end at Milky Way, with participants taking a provided bus to other area Thoroughbred farms. "I love the California-bred program," Madsen said. "I am a really big supporter. Nobody works harder than the people at the CTBA, and those people don't always get the credit they deserve."

Madsen has welcomed racing fans to the farm as well. She said she has received regular visits from a group of people who particularly love Graydar and Midnight Storm. The fan club began when Graydar was racing and extended to his time at Taylor Made.

"They fly out here from all over the United States, especially when the Breeders' Cup is in California," Madsen said. "When we got Midnight Storm, some of them made a special trip out to see him. They've got Graydar T-shirts and send the horses Mrs. Pastures Cookies for Christmas."

Even though most of the Milky Way stallions don't have their own fan club, Madsen loves them all, especially Sundarban, a 2006 son of A.P. Indy and one of her first stallions.

She holds to her principle of diverse pedigrees, even importing a couple of stallions, with Seifert, from South America. Chilean-bred Dosificado is by Scat Daddy, and French champion Passion for Gold is by Medaglia d'Oro.



Way is by a different sire line. Midnight Storm is joining a roster that also includes: Balance the Books, by Lemon Drop Kid; Box Score, by Dynaformer; Circumference, by Galileo; Heaven's Glory, by Tapit; Hoorayforhollywood, by Storm Cat; Moquest, by Uncle Mo; Richmond Street, by Street Cry; Sawyer's Hill, by Spring At Last; Smart Bid, by Smart Strike; Winning Cause, by Giant's Causeway; and Win the Space, by Pulpit.

Madsen and Alvira offer a wide range of services for California breeders. Madsen works with her clients on everything from breeding decisions to foal registrations. She said that Midnight Storm is already attracting new interest.

"It's amazing the number of people who have come to see him," Madsen said. "He's really pretty, and we are so excited to have him. It just worked out—one of those miracles."
