Sandra Snyder, the administration and governance senior manager for the Horse Improvement Program, said that even though there are no tariffs in place, trying to move mares into the U.S. to be bred with sires standing there has become more complicated.

She said the benefits of the stallion awards program, in particular, solidifies the regional roots of the program. In the spring of 2025, the uncertainty had an immediate impact on Canada's horse industry.

"It did change people's choices and behaviors in the spring, for sure, when the first tariffs ... to horses going back and forth across the border (were first mentioned), people made different decisions about where they were going to sell their yearlings," Snyder said. "They made different decisions about taking yearlings across the border earlier if they were selling; that was the plan. Some mares were relocated maybe earlier than they might have been. I think at this stage in the game, people are taking a wait-and-see approach, as I think they are in many businesses, and not making significant long-term changes. But I wouldn't want to say for sure what the long-term implications might be."

Even though tariffs were never put into place, the fear of the financial implications was significant. Adding to the confusion, according to the American Horse Council, there were U.S. Border Patrol agents applying tariffs on not just

the horses, but trailers, tack, bedding, and feed. While some of that is permissible, the possible overall cost of importing a horse served as a deterrent to some.

That's where TIP becomes a life saver. The program had a 2025 budget of \$15.3 million.

Most of the funding comes from Home Market Area wagering, or betting on horses that physically takes place in Ontario. The provincial government sends a percentage of the money generated by pari-mutuel wagering to TIP.

"It's been a tremendous program that we've had in Ontario for several years now," said David Anderson of Ontario-based Anderson Farms. "It's really helped the local breeders and the local owners. It's been a great security blanket, knowing that we've had government support and working with the government, creating jobs, and allowing our industry to flourish."

While breeders and owners can't 🗧 assume there will be a check every month because it is results oriented,

when the check does come, it makes a big difference.

"When it shows up on the 15th of the month, it pays a lot of bills, whether it's the feed man or the blacksmith or the hay man," Anderson said. "It goes a long way over the course of the year, and it's been a hugely successful program."

TIP's purpose is to increase the quality and value of racehorses bred in the province. The breeders and owners of registered horses bred or sired in Ontario are eligible to receive benefits from the program.

Those breeders and owners are finding incentives in various ways: breeder awards, purse bonuses for Ontario-bred horses, Ontario-restricted stakes races, Ontario Sires Stakes, the Sales Stakes Program, stallion awards, and mare and foal incentive programs.

Ontario breeders awards send \$4.75 million back into the industry, while the stallion awards give back \$320,000, and there are awards of \$250,000 for the performance of Ontario-bred horses in graded and group stakes outside of the province.

Another popular element is the mare purchase program, which has no less than \$400,000 allocated. That amount could rise based on Home Market Area

wagering. The mare incentive program runs in alternating years since its founding in 2020. In that time, 181 mares have been brought into Ontario, according to Ontario Racing.

Anderson believes the mare purchase program might be the best such program not just in Ontario or Canada, but in North America. The program returns half of the purchase price in Canadian dollars for any in-foal mare that is brought to Ontario.

"It's allowed Ontario breeders to go outside of Canada and buy some better quality mares and bring them back to the province and foal them and raise them in the province and subsequently have them race there as well," he said.

Perhaps not bringing horses into the U.S. has created unease for Canadian

horsemen. But TIP, which supports not just Thoroughbreds but Quarter Horses and Standardbred horses as well, helps relieve some of the concerns associated with a change in plans.

Anderson said that because tariffs were never put into place by the U.S., it's business as usual for him. But that doesn't mean that TIP hasn't convinced him and others to place greater emphasis on staying at home.

He foals all of his mares in Ontario, but commercially, he breeds to mostly Kentucky sires for his personal program. That, he said, is changing.

"Now I'm looking at bringing more

in Ontario moving forward, because of the government support, and unfortunately, we've suffered from a decline in foal crop, just as everyone else has. But there's opportunity in Ontario. We don't have the competition that you would otherwise have in some of the bigger jurisdictions in the United States."

And there simply isn't a concern about the funds evaporating. Ontario's provincial government agreed to a 19-year funding plan that runs through 2038.

Neither the horsemen, Ontario Racing, nor the provincial government are resting on their laurels. Changes are made as the industry evolves and there are always thoughts on new or revised incentives.

#### **ANOTHER VIEW**

Not everyone views TIP, or at least its current state, positively.

John Burness, who owns Colebrook Farms, believes the program has been in decline over the past decade. He points toward industry-wide factors such as declining foal crops, reduced betting

in Ontario, as well as Woodbine's role in cutting back the Ontario sire purse program. It was \$320,000 in 2025.

In 2016, Woodbine informed horsemen that the bonuses paid out the two previous years had exceeded expectations, and it was going to reduce the program. It paid out \$4.4 million in 2015 and reduced that to nearly \$3 million for 2016. This was done by cutting back on the number of races exclusively restricted to Ontario-sired horses.

At that time, Woodbine Entertainment Group in a letter to horsemen wrote, "As declining horse supply becomes a growing factor, WEG can no longer support a parallel program of open races and restricted OS races."

Colebrook stands one of Canada's top sires, Frac Daddy, who is by Scat Daddy.

"I think we were sort of the model for what's happened in New York and what's happening in several of the states now by having the (sire) program," Burness said.

Burness said that one of the issues facing Canadian horsemen is the taxes in Canada are restrictive, especially when compared to the permanent 100% bonus

depreciation law in the U.S. It keeps some horsemen from buying or breeding in the U.S. In Canada, top sires stand for \$5,000-\$8,000.

"We have maybe about 150 or so people that can afford to go to the U.S., pay the higher dollar and send mares down there, and breed to (a) stallion down there," he said. "But most of the small people that are involved in regional programs, they just don't have the funds to be able to do that. They're kind of stuck here breeding to the Ontario sires."

Having been part of the industry for more than 50 years, Burness said older participants are having a harder time with just a small number of mares and small acreage. He said with the cost of land skyrocketing, many older horsemen are choosing to cash out and "live happily ever after."

#### **PUTTING HEADS TOGETHER**

As for a solution, Burness would like to see Ontario Racing and Woodbine "get together and put up X number

of dollars to go directly to the breeders that are in the game to help them sustain and have them bring in better broodmares, better stallions to get the program up to where we were at one time, back to a better position than we certainly are in now."

"Unless we have some financial help from those entities ... I don't think the sustainability is going to be there," he said.

Still, the program's endgame is to make life easier for Ontario horsemen.

Perhaps it is not as impactful as years past, but it is still making a difference.

Open channels of communication is key. If horsemen see something that needs to be adjusted, there is receptiveness to dialogue.

"We're engaged in a really good listening exercise, gathering information and obtaining feedback," Snyder said. "And there are lots of great ideas out there. One of the good things about being as historic as this program is, we like to try new

things, and we will probably be sharing some things over the next couple years after we sort of finish with our listening exercise and getting feedback from everybody. We always get positive feedback from folks who have used a program and it has worked out well for them. Sometimes, not every program services every participant. There are sometimes things they're requesting to change and (we try to) figure out how to benefit different services."
